## 2. Visa Changes & Zimbos on Cruise ships



Thousands of Zimbabweans also applied online and offered jobs from Botswana, South Africa and Zimbabwe.

From our forum ZBIN, we directly gave free advice to at least 1000 of our members who were successful from online applications and recruitments. A good number of them are still on the forum.

The US Embassy Harare Office was quoted by The Independent to have issued at least 2000 visas for cruise ship job applicants in 2023.

But the majority of visa applicants used the US Embassies in Maputo, Pretoria, Mbabane and Windhoek.

Therefore it's safe to say up to 10,000 Zimbos impacted by the recent US Embassy Visa changes.

Earning an average annual salary of \$10,000 per year. This means the country was earning an average of \$100 million per year as most salaries were remitted back home.

We do not have the full facts as to why the visa tenures were reduced, but from social media reports; it seems the issue could be resolved.

We would also like to believe there is concern for the adverse impact, with high level attention given to the issue.

From our forum, most of those working on cruise ships are hard working youngsters with some helping families, raising capital for businesses and self improvement projects.

We therefore appeal for help on behalf of every Zimbabwean national, so that they keep their jobs and help the nation.

The recent changes in visas by the American Embassy in Harare has adversely impacted thousands of Zimbabweans working on cruise ships.

Some ships have already notified Zimbabwean employees of termination and recruitment from Zimbabwe has been frozen.

At this juncture, cruise ship job recruitment by American Cruiseships of Zimbabweans has been put on ice.

The Zimbabwe Business Ideas and Network (ZBIN) is obviously concerned as we championed the recruitment of cruise ships staff and even had a chartered plane from Carnival Cruise, landing at the Robert Gabriel Mugabe Airport to pick up recruits back in June 2022.

It is difficult to come up with an accurate estimate of the number of Zimbabweans working on cruise ships, but it is important to factor in,

At least 600 recruited directly from Zimbabwe soil at job fairs held in Harare and Bulawayo by Msc Cruise in 2022 and 2023.

By default, collectively; they are also our investors. Some are participating in local projects banking funds in Zimbabwe.

We pray for resolution to the visas impasse as anxiety has gripped 10,000 cruise ship members, their families and dependants.

On behalf of ZBIN and Zimbabweans working on cruise ships.

### 3. How we started



How do you start a business forum? Do you get a team of accountants, economists bankers and ask them to be part of a business forum?

The ideal situation—however it is highly unlikely to work. In small circles—yes but likely to remain a closed group.



So in 2012 we did take an indirect and very long route to a business forum formation.

Grouped 150 complete strangers and formed a Facebook Group called Dare. We started networking online by regularly posting content—including photos, meet ups, visits, parties, hospital visits etc

The idea was to create a strong social group of members dotted across the globe. The trick worked. The best way to bring people together is through social interactions.

You do not start with business that is a difficult topic.

I think in our minds we are still in the era yema300%/200%/100% profit of which the Chinese have penetrated our market and saw the loopholes kuti toda Mari and they are replicating their system kuno reproduction at the lowest cost and supplying to people,I was shocked yesterday takaenda kunotenga mawig eUSD\$2 or USD\$3 that to you will be sold at USD\$15 or USD\$20 but because of the competition prices are coming down and it will soon be about how much volumes can you push,and that's where these Chinese guys beat us isu tajaira kuisa zino.Look at bottled water they have penetrated selling it at a lower price,kare you will be charged a dollar for branded water for a function now it's much cheaper,those guys are bringing in machinery, human

you will see kuti tichapedzisira tasvikako chete. For example, S.A vanoitaa huku dziri cheap futi zvisinei basa kuti iRange ipi. Brazil exports chicken products to S.A futi at a cheaper cost, but still they don't meet the consumption rate. The demand is still higher but the price inongokuudza kuti even in Zimbabwe tichapedzisira taenda ikoko and we must up our game kuManufacturing

**Phin Dube:** Where it permits, you are allowed to do the 300% in business. This issue of very low prices and volumes is for people with a strong financial backbone. These Chinese you are talking about don't come to Zim with \$20k, they are millionaires. Their buying power allows them to buy a product at \$0.20 yet at your level you will be able to buy the same product at \$1.

**Mai Mrehwa:** But comparing the locals with the chinese is always unfair. Sadly these Chinese have many advantages and are always benefiting. Authorities seem to favour and are also lenient with the Chinese and they get away with a lot which the locals cant. In short matsotsi ayo.

**Kuda Chifamba Makuvaza:** In Zimbabwe nowadays, "Don't think outside the box" but you

must, I repeat, you must "Think without the box". Business opportunities are everywhere and they are abundant, zvakuenderana ne\_amount of capital to be invested, be it in Transport, Mining, Education, Retailing, Manufacturing, Farming etc.

**Christy Chitsa:** Are the Chinese paying all the taxes required in Zim? In the past we would put 100% plus mark ups because we'd pay all the taxes before they came up with a whole lot of those. You'll find of the 100% mark up your profit will be 20% if operating by the book. So to be competitive with the Chinese one is forced to evade the taxes. You purchase something for \$1 and sell for \$1.30, the business math is not mathing already because ZIMRA, NSSA etc have to be paid from that. So the net profit will be in the negative.

## 6. How to set up a pub



So in 2009 I used to hang out at this small braai stand at Highglen Shopping centre. I would call it my best hang out place ever. The place became so popular and started attracting patrons from far and wide. The exponential growth led to the management of the mall closing down the place on health compliance grounds. It was later reopened, but without the braai stand (Lesson No 1)

### The Braai Magic

Unlike Mereki where one waits in the car with runners buying meat, have it sorted, and delivered. The Highglen braai stand was a self service venue.

*Nyama inonakisisa uchiidyira pamoto...uchimbodanzura...woisiya.....one piece at a time. Uchiwonawo vamwe varikugocha. This was the original recipe of Mereki in the late 80s. Vana Mai George vasati vauya.*

You buy your meat, drinks and take your time in perfecting your culinary skills. Pace inenge iri kwauri—and enjoy the company of strangers. It was a gentlemen's club—and surprisingly very exciting. Visit the bar, next the butcher and off to the braai stand. (Lesson No 2)

After the closure of the place—I hooked up with a friend Tinashe and we opened a pub in Mufakose. Hameno kana uchiziva paive ne Dairiboard? We got the place and opened a pub, butchery and added the magic of the braai stand.

BUT there was a problem—we were strangers in Mfombi—nobody knew us, and we knew nobody.

### Start Up headaches?

We scouted the area and found a boozers club which played on weekends. Engaged them—bought a new soccer kit and offered a free crate after every match. (Lesson No 3). We also added a professional dj although I had argued it was not necessary (Lesson No 4)

The trick worked—the place became community owned as word travelled faster. And with time we had captured the suburb. Instead of travelling to Mereki—some patrons from Mufakose, Kambuzuma and Budiriro opted for our place.

### The curse of the self service braai stand

The landlord shocked by the magic at his premises—increased rentals from \$600 to \$1800 within a period of 6 months. Pfungwa dzekuti rega ndiite ndirini dzakange dzauya.

*We moved out and found a place at Kambuzuma 2 Shopping Centre.*

Corrected mistakes by engaging a lawyer to draft a water tight lease agreement. Spruced up the place and plugged Lessons (1-4). The magic worked instantly.

We still had our boozers team and we thought we had finally arrived.

*Aaah inonzi Harare...landlady kwakuti lets share the pub ndichitengesawo doro rangu imomo?  
Aikaka, chirudzii?  
Tine lease ka isu?*

*Zvikanzi munonyatsondiziva mushe mushe?*


**Tichafa Msiniwa:**The real deal here is sales promotion if it's I you you can do it any where. Land lords keep on chasing us but wherever we are we win.
